Millwork Expertise Extends Far Beyond Cabinetry

ISI's field staff is widely thought to be in a class of their own when it comes to installing panel systems, wood furniture lines, architectural wall systems, and window shades. Given the nature of

the materials involved, projects performed by our Millwork Division often do a particularly good job of showcasing ISI workmanship. Consistent demonstration of millwork expertise has led to more complex installations as well as substantial growth in this area of the business.

In a healthcare corporation headquarters, for example, an ISI millwork team installed a corporate logo wall that was approximately nine feet wide and more than two stories tall. The wall was composed of raised painted wood blocks that came in sections varying in size up to 4 feet by 8 feet. Setting these sections into the opening created by the removal of existing wood panels was a lengthy process and required the use of scaffolding and lifts. The install became more challenging as the team worked to level and secure the sections at the higher elevations. As part of the same project, the ISI team installed wood slats designed to go over some new product display walls, adhering to precise layout specifications required for image and lighting alignments.

Another ISI millwork team installed a high-end reception/security station at a private university. The station was delivered to site in about 40 pieces, including the curved crown molding, trim and column wraps. Our team installed all elements of the station except for the tile fascia below the transaction counter. "We were very impressed with how meticulous they were with every detail," the Security Manager said.

Sometimes how the job gets done is as distinctive as the trade craft that goes into it. One project called for making approximately 100 custom cuts for power drops in table tops at a site

where construction was in full swing. Our foreman turned an ISI trailer into a shop where the cuts could be accomplished, thereby minimizing the client's product handling costs.


